- We found ourselves bottoms up in the Northwest when we had metal shavings in our rear end (OUCH!) and were forced to buy a rear differential from the Crow Indians in



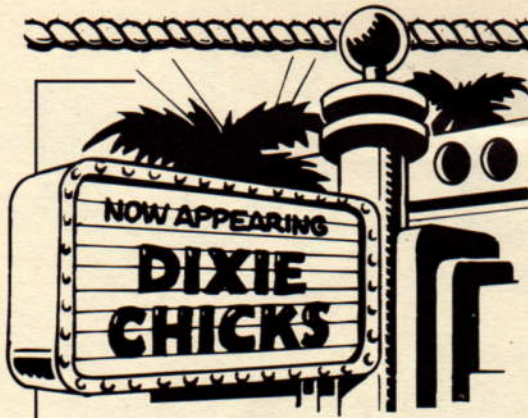
The Armadillo himself, Gary P Nunn, sang a few tunes with us at our Broken Spoke Show.
