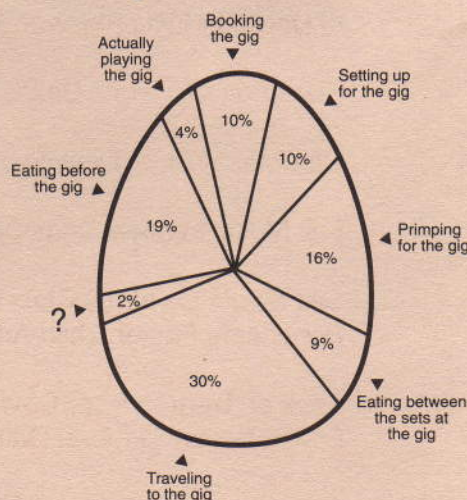

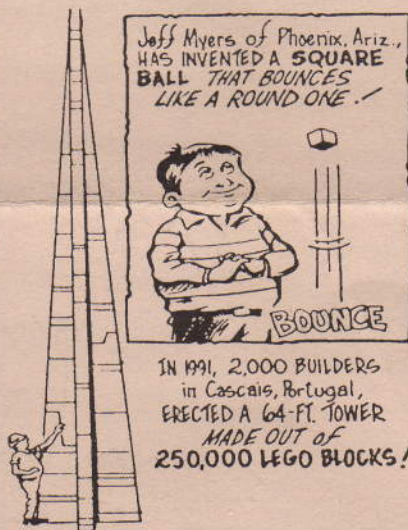
*On July 28, 1992, after three years, my

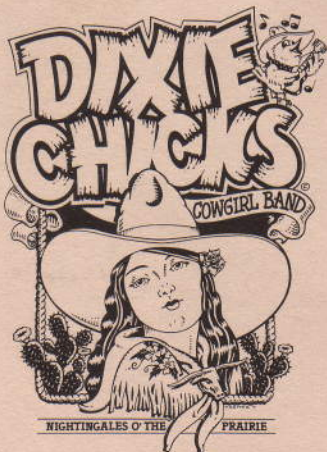


**"THE DIXIE CHICKS," A Dallas, Texas, BASED
